

1. Requests for Production of Documents and Things, Requests for Admissions, Interrogatories and Depositions may proceed pursuant to 29 C.F.R. §§ 2200.53 – 2200.56 and/or the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure.

2. The number of depositions that may be taken by a party may not exceed ten absent leave of the court.


