Based upon the following recital, the Complainant and the Respondent herein agree to the following as a conclusion of this matter:

- 1. The Complainant, ROBERT B. REICH, Secretary of Labor, United States Department of Labor, hereby withdraws Item 1 of Citation No. 2.
- 2. The Complainant, ROBERT B. REICH, Secretary of Labor, United States Department of Labor, hereby amends the notification(s) of proposed penalty to reflect a total amended proposed penalty of \$2,500 to be assessed as follows:

- 3. Based upon the above, the Respondent, NAVIERAS NPR, INC., herein withdraws its notice of contest as to the citation(s) and notification(s) of proposed penalty, as modified herein.
 - 4. Respondent affirmatively states that:
 - All violations alleged in the citation(s) have been abated. (a)
- 5. Respondent affirmatively states that it will comply in the future with the Occupational Safety and Health Act.
- 6. Respondent certifies that on November 8, 1996, this stipulation will be posted where affected employees may see it.
- 7. On or before 12/1/96, Respondent will pay the amended proposed penalty of \$2,500 by forwarding a check made payable to "Occupational Safety and Health-Labor" in that amount to the U.S. Department of Labor - OSHA, BBV Plaza Building, Suite 5B, 1510 FD Roosevelt Avenue, Guaynabo, Puerto Rico 00968.
- 8. This proposed Stipulated Settlement is not to be taken as an admission for the purpose of any proceeding other than one arising under the Occupational Safety and Health Act.

9. Each party hereby agrees to bear its own fees and other expenses incurred by such party in connection with any stage of this proceeding.
